* Applicants may also provide documentation of safety course training (HBA and/or other third party certification) completed as evidence of meeting levels 1, 2, or 3 training course requirements.

** Guideline only. To be used for baseline information only by the HomeSafe® Colorado Job Site Safety Committee.

HomeSafe Colorado Membership:

- The cost of HomeSafe Colorado Builder Membership is as follows:
 HBA Builder Members \$150 with annual renewal fee of \$50
 Non-HBA Builder Members\$ 225 with annual renewal fee of \$100
- The cost of HomeSafe Colorado Associate Membership for any General Contractors, Trade Partners and Suppliers who want to become Home Safe® members is as follows:
 HBA Associate Member.....\$75 with annual renewal fee of \$50
 Non-HBA Associate Member\$150 with annual renewal fee of \$100
