

In order for an associate member to receive <u>Builder Magazine</u> you must be classified with an occupation code. Any other classification codes must also be further defined by writing the specific occupation.

SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS BUILDER MEMBERS ONLY

Builder members are levied an assessment on single-family, multi-familiy and condominium housing units based upon the following schedule:

- For the first 250 building permits pulled per year, if the assessed value of the home is:

- \$0 - \$500,000 \$150.00 - \$500,001 - \$1,000,000 \$195.00 - \$1,000.001+ \$325.00

\$20.00 of each unit assessment is forwarded to the Colorado Association of Home Builders for an Industry Promotional Assessment.

Code of Ethics

Utilizing exceptional business practices as they relate to home owners, employees, trade partners and fellow members of the association, we as members of the Home Builders Association of Metro Denver ascribe to and assume the responsibility of abiding with the following code of ethics. We therefore commit to:

- · Conduct business affairs with professionalism, honesty and integrity; and
- Participate in an ongoing process of continuing education related to state of the art building and management practices
- Uphold and engage in sound financial business practices
- Act professionally, making good faith efforts to meet contractual, moral and ethical obligations and commitments with regard to their business activities
- Stay current and in compliance with local, state and federal policies, laws, immigration regulations, building practices and other essential information that affect our business interests and those of the building industry as a whole
- Provide housing, related services and products that are in compliance with or surpass the building codes, safety regulations and environmental standards
- Maintain a comprehensive warranty process that responsibly meets the needs of consumers
- Avoid the appearance of, or actual unfair advantage over fellow members. Abide by a covenant of fair dealing and integrity by establishing a trusting relationship with the buying public and members
- Avoid intentionally harming directly or indirectly, privately or publicly, the professional reputation, customer relations, or business of other members of this association.

We shall uphold all these principles and commitments, resolving any disputes that arise in a fair and expeditious manner. We shall be vigilant against conduct that has the intent or capability of being deceptive towards our customers or fellow members of this association from a moral or ethical standpoint.

Dues Allocation: \$166 of your dues goes to the National Association of Home Builders; \$175 to the Colorado Association of Home Builders and \$509 to the Home Builders Association of Metro Denver.

Tax Deduction Disclosure: Association memberships are not 100% tax deductible as an ordinary business expense pursuant to the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993. The non-deductible portion of your dues for 2016 is \$133.51.

Understand and Agree: Check Accept or Do Not Accept to indicate your understanding and agreement with the following statement: "I understand that a portion of my dues will be transferred to the Committee for the American Dream and the Metro Housing Coalition, both Political Committees under Colorado law, and to Homes for All Coloradoans, a Small Donor Committee under Colorado Law." If your company has an explicit policy against contributing to political committees or small donor committees, choose Do Not Accept and include a statement specifying your objection in the text box provided at the bottom of this page. The \$128.75 will be transferred instead to a general fund.
